Mr. Koenig has nearly 30 years experience in global clean energy markets, where he has held executive offices in Germany and the United States, in the nuclear and renewables sector, at engineering, manufacturing, and service companies as well as in trading and with a large utility/investor.

His international nuclear experience spans the front- and backend of the fuel cycle, new build, as well as decommissioning and remediation:

- In his Advisory role, since 2014 Mr. Koenig has worked with new-build investors on their program development, procurement activities, and long-term waste and decommissioning strategies; helped engineering companies on market strategies and bidding efforts; supported a nuclear power plant operator in a tender process for a major refurbishment project. Recently, he participated in a think tank effort to advise the US Government on issues regarding international respositories in the context of the International Framework for Nuclear Energy Cooperation (IFNEC).
- Between 2007 and 2013 Mr. Koenig was key in developing, implementing and ultimately selling several new build projects in several countries for a European utility investor and served as Chairman of the New Build Task Force at FORATOM, the European nuclear industry association. This included developing and modelling fuel cycle and disposal strategies and supply chain management.
- As Managing Director of GNB mbH (Germany) and Chairman and President of its subsidiary GNSI Inc (USA) he was responsible for a leading global supplier of spent fuel and HLW storage and transport solutions. This included interaction with Non Proliferation Trust (USA) who had identified GNB's technology for their proposed international repository program.
- Prior to that, he spent several years as President & CEO of NUKEM NT Corp. (USA) providing waste management, decommissioning, and remediation solutions to the U.S. DOE and commercial markets.
- Between 1988 and 1995 he was Head of Trading and Commodity Finance for the leading international nuclear fuel trader, NUKEM GmbH (Germany). This involved detailed analysis and extensive interaction with technologies and markets in the nuclear fuel cycle mining, conversion, enrichment, fabrication.
